AGENDA ITEM Veterans Day of Honor Parade on Saturday, November 7, 2020 at 2 PM.

BACKGROUND Lisa Wilson with the Independence Chamber of Commerce has completed a parade permit requesting authorization to block City streets for the Veterans' Day of Honor on November 7, 2020 at 2 PM. 2017 was the first year for the Veterans' Day of Honor Parade in Independence Kansas. Due to the amount of people that have attended this event in the past two years, Lisa Wilson is requesting the following streets be blocked for the celebration from 10 AM to 5 PM:

- Pennsylvania Avenue from Poplar to Maple-Parade staging area
- Maple from 6th to 8th-Parade staging area
- E. Myrtle from Pennsylvania Ave. east to the Alley-Access controlled parking for limited mobility participants
- W. Laurel Street from Pennsylvania Ave. west to the alley-Access controlled parking for limited mobility participants
- Locust Street from 6th Street to Pennsylvania Avenue-Children's recreation displays

Section 2-341 of City code provides the City Clerk the authority to issue parade permits after being reviewed by the Chief of Police, Director of Public Works, and the City Manager.


