AGENDA ITEM Consider initiating a public hearing to consider a text amendment to the zoning code to allow Medical clinics, outpatient services in an M-1 zone as either a permitted or a conditional use.

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION Initiate a public hearing for a text amendment to the zoning code.

BACKGROUND We have received a request from Labette Health to initiate a public hearing for a text amendment to consider allowing Medical clinics, outpatient services in an M-1 zone. If approved by the Planning Commission and City Commission, the text amendment would allow medical clinics and outpatient services in an M-1 zone as either a permitted or conditional use. If the Commission would like to consider this change, then we would recommend initiating a text amendment. If approved a public hearing will be held before the Planning Commission on April 6, 2021. It will go back before the City Commission for final approval and adoption of an ordinance at your April 22, 2021 meeting.
