

ORDINANCE NO. 4250

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 10,
BLOOM'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, KANSAS

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Independence, Kansas:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted in KSA 14-423, the alley located in Block 10 of Bloom's Addition to the City of Independence, Kansas is hereby vacated.

Section 2. Pursuant to statute, ownership of the alley shall revert to the owners of real estate adjacent thereto on each side in proportion to the frontage of such real estate.

Section 3. For the reason that there are no utilities located in the alley, no reservation for utilities is made.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its publication in the official city newspaper unless one or more interested parties file a written protest before expiration of said time.
