Sales Tax Report for April 2019

One Percent Sales Tax – General Fund

The attached spreadsheet and graphs provide comparisons by fiscal year of the **one (1) percent** sales tax levied for City purposes; another one percent is levied for the Special Use Sales Tax Allocation, and another one percent for education.

NOTE: the “receipts” reported from the State of Kansas to the City for any given month are from sales generated two months prior. For example, the April receipts shown in this report were from sales in February 2019.

April 2019 is the fourth month in the FY2019 Sales Tax Revenue account.

- **April** receipts totaled **\$139,790**, which is a **DECREASE of \$15,912** from April 2018, or **down 10.2%**. Please look at the Graph II, “March 1% Sales Tax 10 Year History” in the attached report.
- Sales tax receipts are up **4.2 percent** for the first four months of 2019, or **\$657,857**, which is **\$26,249** over the first four months total in 2018 of \$631,608.
- On a straight-line projection, sales tax budgeted for FY2019, with only four months reported, **would project at \$1,973,571, or \$18,482** over our **FY2018 actual** amount of \$1,955,089.
- Also, on a straight-line projection sales tax budgeted for FY2019, with only four months reported, **would project at \$42,471** over our **budgeted** amount of \$1,931,100; this would be a one percent increase for the year.
- April’s receipts **do not follow the historical trend** of a larger amount over the previous month of March (see graph “Sales Tax History Comparison – FY2016 – FY 2019”). No explanation other than perhaps the reporting period for March-April of 2019 was different than March-April of 2018. March 2019 had an unusually large increase over March 2018; not enough data, however, to draw any conclusions. Also, interestingly, the “Compensating Use Tax” portion of the total sales tax was **up 16.2%**, while the regular sales tax portion was **down 20.1%** (see graph “2019 Sales Tax – One Percent General Fund” on page four).






Sales Tax FY 2018 - FY2019 Comparison




March 1% Sales Tax 10 Year History FY 2009 - FY2019
