If you are needing to turn on electrical service or gas to your residence or business, please follow these instructions.

Everygy for electrical service, go to the webpage at <https://www.everygy.com/> and you can start the service online or call 800-383-1183

1. New service or service that has been disconnected for 30-days requires an electrical inspection.
2. The owner is required to contact a local electrician to inspect the meter box (service entrance to the residence) and breaker box.
3. The Electrician will contact the City Building Inspector for a city inspection sticker.
4. The City Inspector will notify Everygy.
5. The Electrician will need to schedule the turn on with Everygy.

1. If a City inspection is required, please get in touch with a local licensed plumber, who will perform a shut-in test.
2. The City Building Inspector will inspect the shut-in test and place an inspection sticker if it passes.
3. The City Building Inspector will notify Atmos of the inspection. The owner will need to call Atmos and inform them they have passed inspection.
