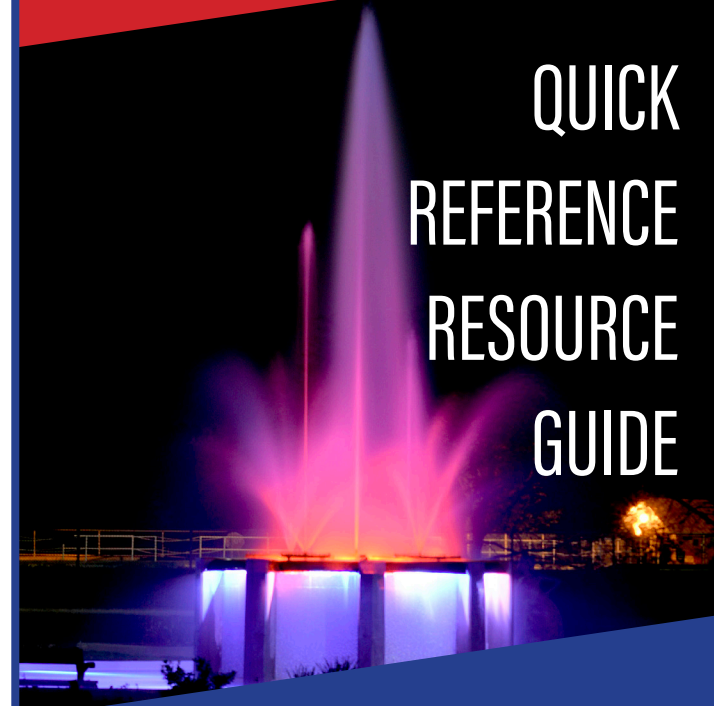

WATER, SEWER & TRASH SERVICES

To set up water, sewer and trash services please contact City Hall. You will need:

- Driver's license
- Social Security card.

A 90-gallon trash cart will be delivered to your address. Find an interactive map of the trash pick-up schedule on the City's website.

WATER/SEWER LEAKS OR EMERGENCIES

In the event of a water/sewer leak or emergency on your property after business hours (after 5 p.m. weekdays or on weekends), contact the Water Plant at 620-332-2515

RECYCLING, BULKY TRASH & BRUSH

Recycling is offered free of charge to Independence residents at the City Sanitation Yard, 21st & Maple.

- Every Tuesday (except holidays), 11 a.m.-1 p.m.
- First Saturday of the month (except holidays), 8 a.m.-12 noon

What is accepted:

Some plastics, non-slick paper, cardboard, glass, aluminum, metal cans and some appliances. Find more details on the City's website (search: **Recycling**).

Household hazardous waste is collected by Montgomery County, 112 N. Wald, on the 3rd Wednesday of the month, March-November.

Bulky trash items (appliances, furniture, etc.), may be dropped off:

- Each Thursday (except holidays), 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The **City Brush Dump** is open to the public:

- First Saturday of the month (except holidays), 8 a.m. to 12 noon. The dump is located on County Road 4100, one-half mile south of College Ave.

RESIDENTIAL DUMPSTER PROGRAM

One 8-yard dumpster per year for \$75 after establishing one year of residency at the address requested for this service.

LICENSES & PERMITS

Anyone doing business within the city limits must have a city license. Applications can be found online or in the Clerk's office. Building permits, right-of-way permits, etc., contact the Building Inspector.

GARAGE/RUMMAGE SALES

Permit required, \$2.50. Purchase at City Hall the week of the sale. Sales are listed on the City's website. Maximum of 5 sales allowed per address per year.

BUILDING RENTAL

Check the City's website for rental space rates and availability at Riverside Park and Memorial Hall.

STORM SHELTERS

- **Memorial Hall/Civic Center**, 410 N. Penn
- **Independence City Hall**, 811 W. Laurel
- **Montgomery Co. Judicial Ctr. Basement**, 300 E. Main
- **Independence High School Gymnasium**, 1301 N. 10th

NOTE: There is no "all clear" signal after storm sirens have sounded. The sirens will stop cycling when they are canceled. Sign up to receive emergency alerts on the website or text your zip code to **38276**.

MUNICIPAL COURT

Each Wednesday at 1:30 p.m. Fines are paid to the court clerk by cash, check, money order or debit/credit card, or may also be paid online.

COMPLAINTS

Environmental or Rental Property Complaints: Tall grass, junk cars, excessive trash, etc., or concerns about rental property, call Code Enforcement.
