BACKGROUND The City has been using the Historic District boundaries for several years as the Fire District. The current official Fire Limits boundaries encompass many residences which would preclude them from being able to set off fireworks or have recreational pit fires.

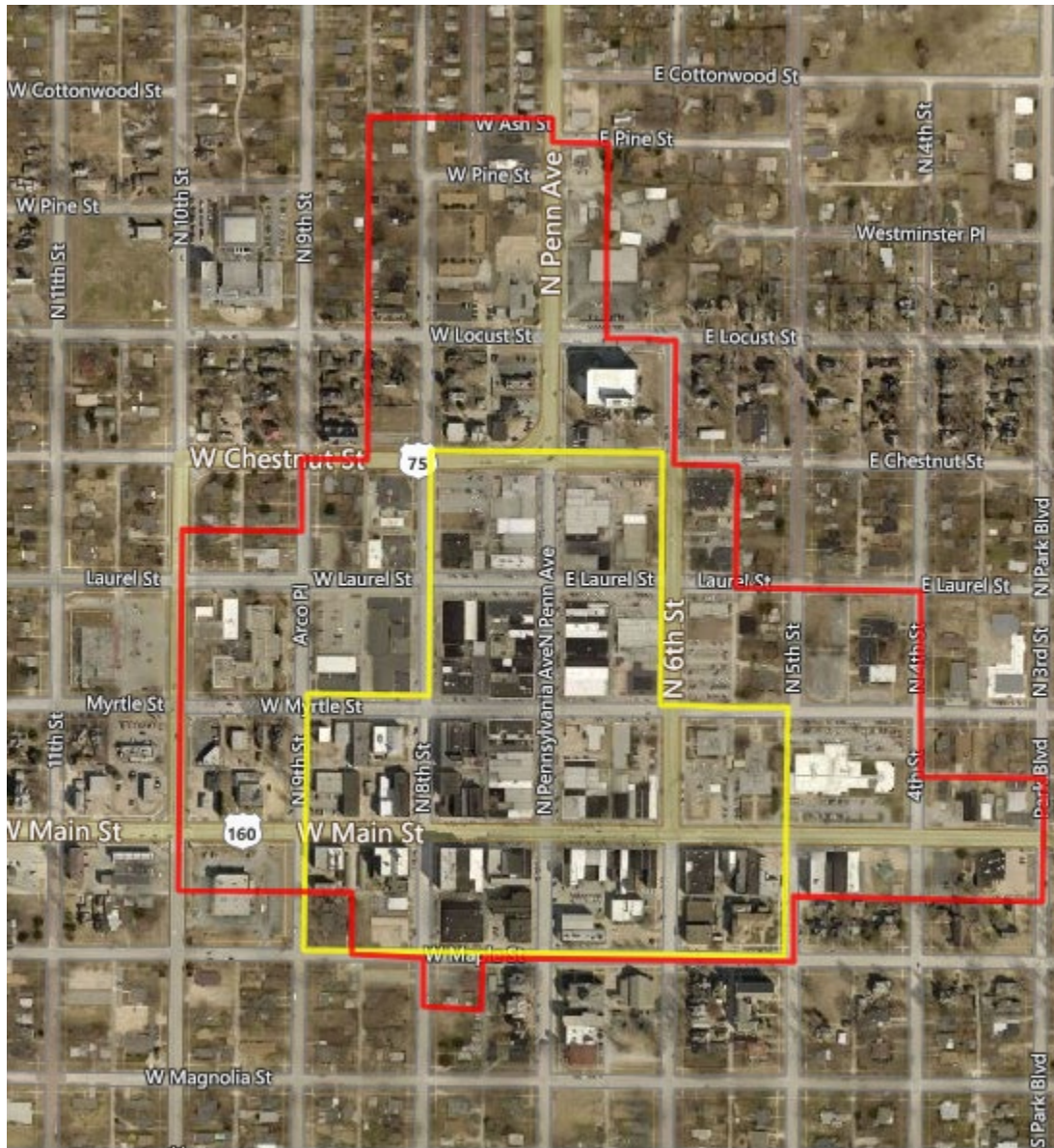

ORDINANCE NO. 4293

**An Ordinance Amending the Definition
Of the Fire Limits of the City of Independence**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Independence, Kansas:

Section 1. City Code Section 18-1 describing the fire limits of the City of Independence, Kansas, is here amended to read as follows:

The following shall be the fire limits of the City:

Beginning at the center line of South 9th Street and West Maple Street;
Thence North to the center line of West Myrtle Street;
Thence East to the center line of North 8th Street;
Thence North to the center line of West Chestnut Street;
Thence East to the center line of North 6th Street;
Thence South to the center line of East Myrtle Street;
Thence East to the center line of North 5th Street;
Thence South to the center line of East Maple Street;
Thence West to the center line of South 9th Street which is the point of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official City newspaper.
