Please place Coffeyville Resources on the agenda for the August 8th, 2019 agenda. In order to maintain the pipeline running under Laurel St. near the old Sonic, we will need to request a temporary closure of Laurel Street. It is anticipated that the minimum closure length will be one week, and the largest factor in having a longer closure is the weather. Ordinarily boring is preferred in a location such as this, but there are several aspects that make boring difficult: The existing line is cased. New lines are no longer installed as cased lines, and we will be installing new piping of increased thickness in this location. The area is congested.

- There are multiple active petroleum pipelines running parallel and in close proximity to our line.
- Running perpendicular to our line is an active water line.
- Running perpendicular to our line is an active fiber optic line.
- Additional lines may be uncovered as the area is prepared for excavation.

We will work with the City to properly sign the work site to minimize disruption and produce a quality finished product that will enhance public safety.
