AGENDA ITEM Consider authorizing the installation of an audio control processor and wall screen controls for the Memorial Hall audio/visual system.

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION City Staff is recommending approval of an audio control processor and wall screen controls for the Memorial Hall audio/visual system.

BACKGROUND On November 12, 2020 the City Commission approved installation of AV (audio/visual) equipment at Memorial Hall to allow for live streaming and recording of City meetings. The Civic Center audio processor was deleted due to funding. Since installation of the equipment it has become evident that the audio processor is needed in order to properly operate the system. Staff is recommending installation of the processor and controls for \$8,145.00.

City Staff will be bringing the following Memorial Hall maintenance and improvement projects to the Commission within the next 30-60 days:

1. Rigging System
 - a. The City has prepared a scope of work to repair the items identified in the last JR Clancey inspection. This work was previously delayed due to the pandemic.
 - i. PowerLifts – Repair (lubrication) and decommission of 10 PowerLifts, reprogram controls.
 - ii. Cable drum roller repair
 - iii. Tailstock maintenance
 - iv. Fire curtain pull station maintenance
 - v. Limit switch reset
 - b. Smoke hatch replacement -- This issue was also identified in the last JR Clancey inspection and was delayed due to the pandemic.
 - i. Smoke hatch procurement and installation
 - ii. Smoke hatch rigging installation
 - c. Water damage
 - i. Investigation of water damage to Balcony and Ticket Booth
 - ii. Examination of downspouts for blockage and cleaning
 - iii. Repairs to historic doors on the North and West entrances.

2. AV Project for the Auditorium

- a. Project to purchase and install projectors in the auditorium for electronic theatrical backdrops, presentations, rebroadcast of live streaming events, and videos in the auditorium. Neewollah is partnering with the City on this project by contributing funds.
