### V. ITEMS FOR COMMISSION ACTION

A. Consider authorizing staff to draft modifications to City Code relating to HVAC and

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Mechanical work.

The City of Independence has adopted the 2012 Uniform Mechanical Code. The building department uses this code to approve new construction and installation of the mechanical and HVAC systems. The City Code currently does not regulate local HVAC installation, service and/or repair of existing mechanical units beyond requiring a local business license. The City has been contacted by a local business and received several citizen complaints requesting mechanical inspections and codes in the City. City Staff also visited with the Electrical and Plumbing Boards, with both Boards agreeing codes and inspections need to be implemented.

City Staff is requesting direction whether the Commission would like us to proceed with drafting modifications to City Code relating to HVAC and Mechanical work. Once the draft is completed, it would be presented to the Commission for adoption by ordinance. City Staff will work with the local City licensed HVAC businesses and City Attorney in the development of these codes. City Staff has provided a copy of Parsons Mechanical Code.

- B. Consider authorizing an agreement with Mega, LLC to continue additional work previously bid for Whiskey Creek drainage way clearing.

City of Independence received one bid for the Whiskey Creek drainage way clearing from MEGA, LLC. As requested, they submitted pricing for three phases of work as follows:

Cherry north to Walnut approved on August 13, 2020 in the amount of \$84,000.

Laurel to Walnut was bid at \$46,000.

Laurel to Pine was bid at \$63,000.

Cherry Street to Walnut has been completed. City Staff is recommending approving Walnut to Laurel Street in the amount of \$46,000.

- C. Consider authorizing the Mayor to sign the KDOT Maple Street Cost Share Agreement.

The City of Independence was awarded a \$1.6 million cost share grant to improve Maple Street from 17<sup>th</sup> to West of Peter Pan Road. The proposed Maple Street project is estimated to cost \$2,635,452 with KDOT providing \$1,594,089 and the City matching \$1,041,363.

City of Independence was notified of a sanitary sewer blockage on January 8, 2021, in the area of 1<sup>st</sup> and Birch. The sanitary sewer system in this area is a private sewer system installed sixty-plus years ago. The age, condition, and how the service is running makes repair impossible and could put 10 to 12 houses in danger of losing sanitary sewer. Shawn Turner will be present to provide the Commission with an update and plan to install a City sanitary sewer system for this area.
