AGENDA ITEM Consider adopting an ordinance modifying the fees related to regulation-required pretreatment permits to offset City testing costs.

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION Authorization changing the pretreatment fee to \$650 annually.

BACKGROUND Pretreatment permits are required by regulation for certain businesses that have wastewater. In this case, there are only two businesses with pretreatment permits.

The fee for the permits had been a one-time permit fee of \$150 for a five-year permit. Annual external laboratory testing of the effluent costs (last year) \$650 per business. By making the permit fee an annual \$650, the fee would offset the incremental costs incurred by the City for testing. This permit fee is anticipated to be budget neutral.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Independence, Kansas:

Section 1.	Appendix D, Chapter 106, Utilities, is amended to add a new subsection
(17) as follows:

(17)	Annual fee for those businesses requiring a pretreatment permit \$650.00
Section 2.	Existing subsections (17) and (18) under Chapter 106, Utilities, are hereby
amended to be re-nu	mbered as subsections (18) and (19).
