Sales Tax Report for September 2019

One Percent Sales Tax – General Fund

The attached spreadsheet and graphs provide comparisons by fiscal year of the **one (1) percent** sales tax levied for City purposes; another one percent is levied for the Special Use Sales Tax Allocation, and another one percent for Education.

NOTE: the “receipts” reported from the State of Kansas to the City for any given month are from sales generated two months prior. For example, the September receipts shown in this report were from sales in July 2019.

September 2019 is the ninth month in the FY2019 Sales Tax Revenue account.

- **September** receipts totaled **\$186,618**, which is an **INCREASE of \$26,805** from September 2018, or **up 16.8%** (see Graph 2, “September 1% Sales Tax 10 Year History”).
- Sales tax receipts are up **5.2 percent** for the first nine months of 2019, totaling **\$1,540,042**, which is **\$75,809 over** the first nine months total in 2018 of \$1,304,420.
- On a straight-line projection, sales tax budgeted for FY2019, with nine months reported, **would project total 2019 receipts at \$2,030,137 or \$75,048 over our FY2018 actual** amount of \$1,464,233.
- Also, on a straight-line projection sales tax budgeted for FY2019, with nine months reported, **would project \$122,290 over** our **budgeted** amount of \$1,931,100; this would be **6.3 percent higher** than the budget.
- After nine months, we have **collected 79.7%** of our budgeted amount.
- September 2019 amount is the **highest dollar amount for the month of September** in the 10-year reporting history (see Graph 2, “September 1% Sales Tax 10 Year History”).
- The **Compensating Use** sales tax portion made up 9.3 percent of the \$186,618 total (\$17,407) (see Graph 5 “2019 1% Sales Tax – Monthly/Compensating Use Sales Tax and Sales Tax.”).

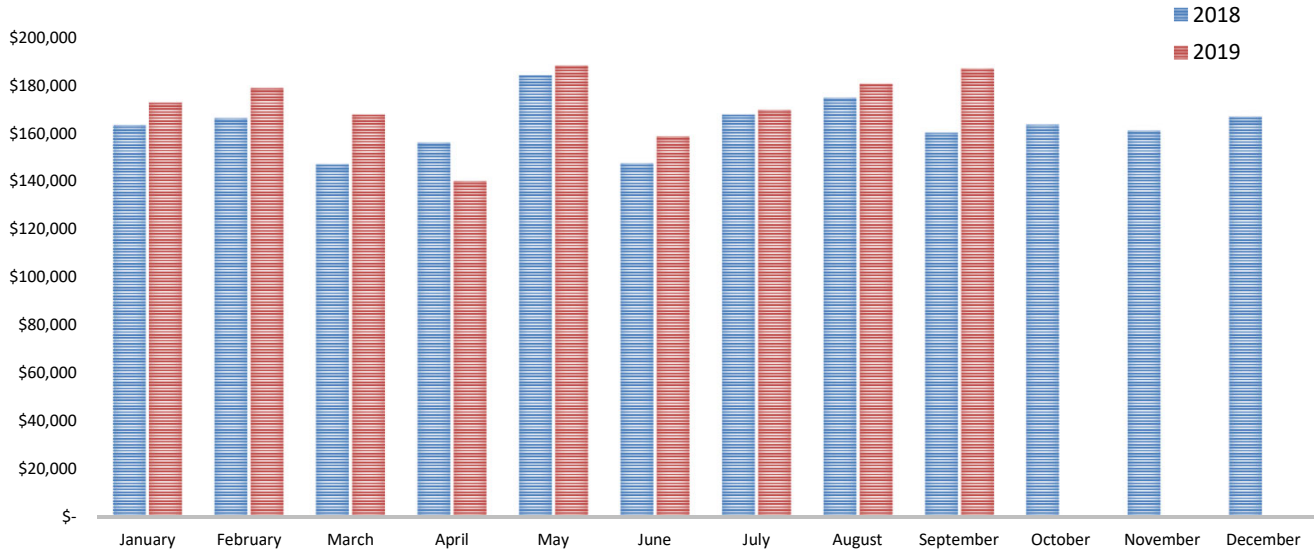

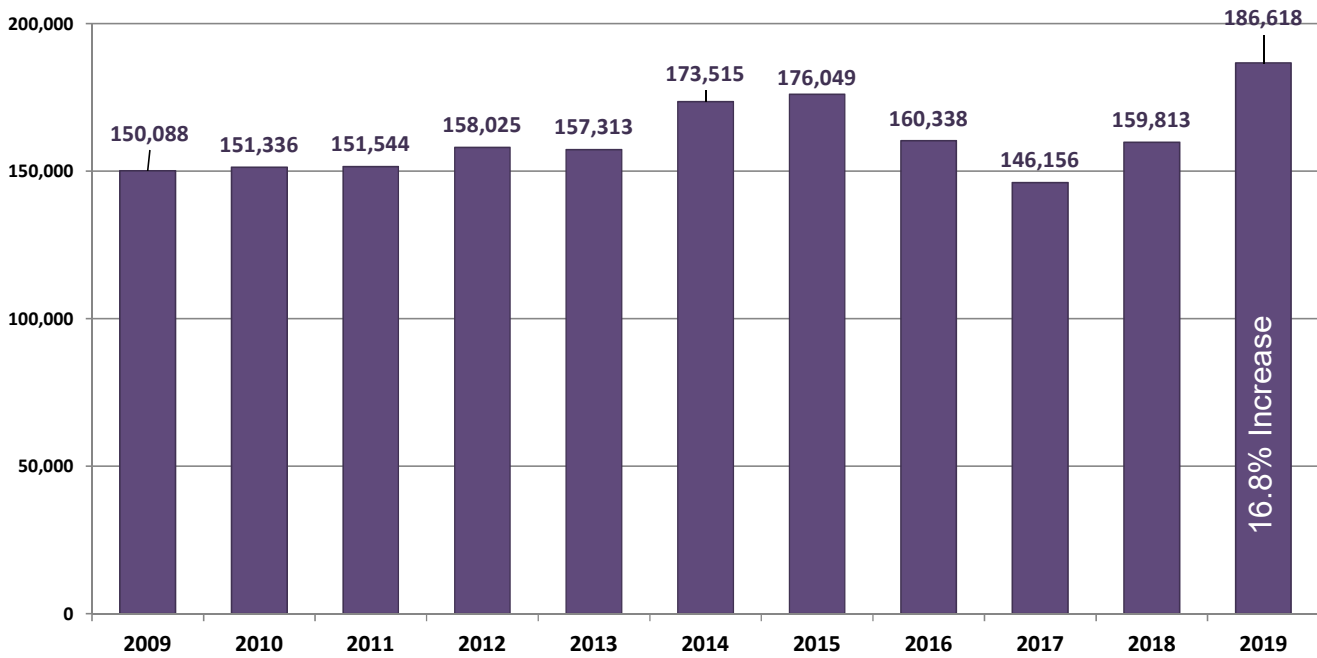

1% Sales Tax FY2018 - FY2019 Comparison



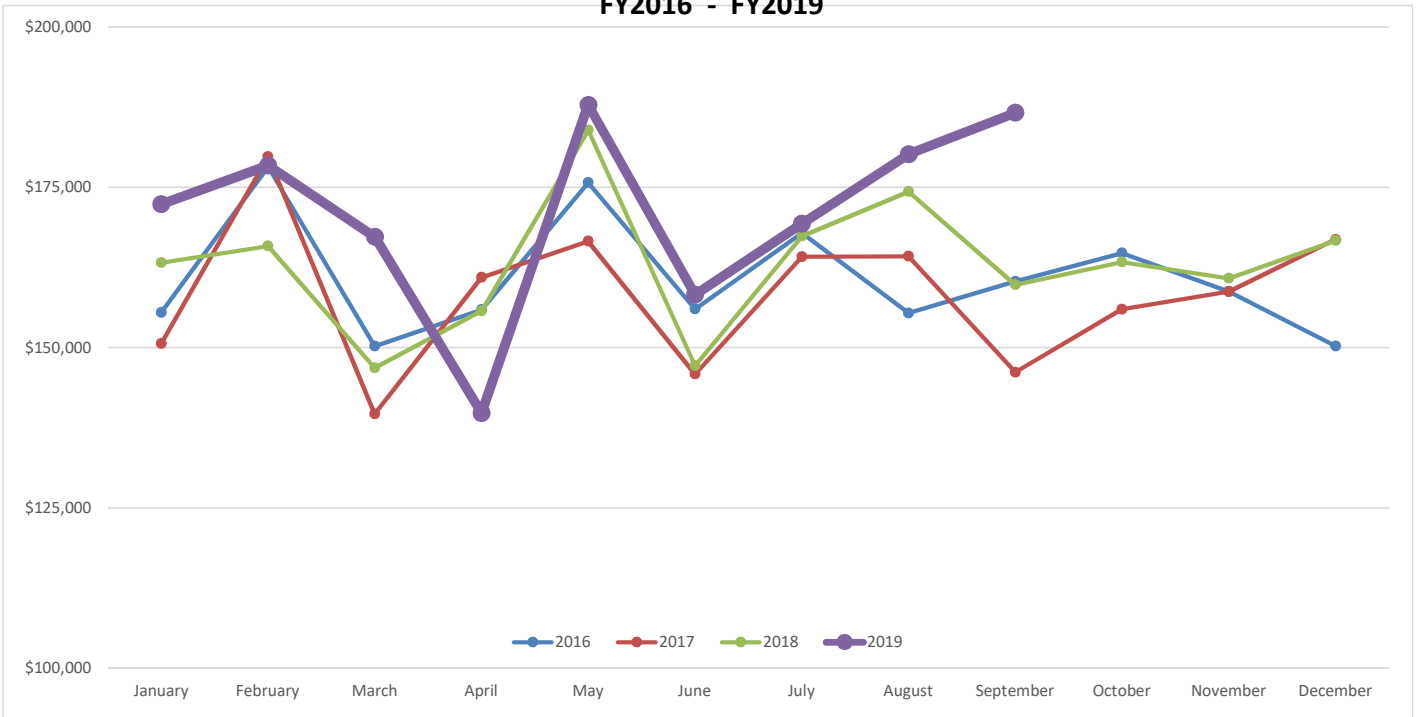

September 1% Sales Tax 10 Year History FY 2009 - FY2019



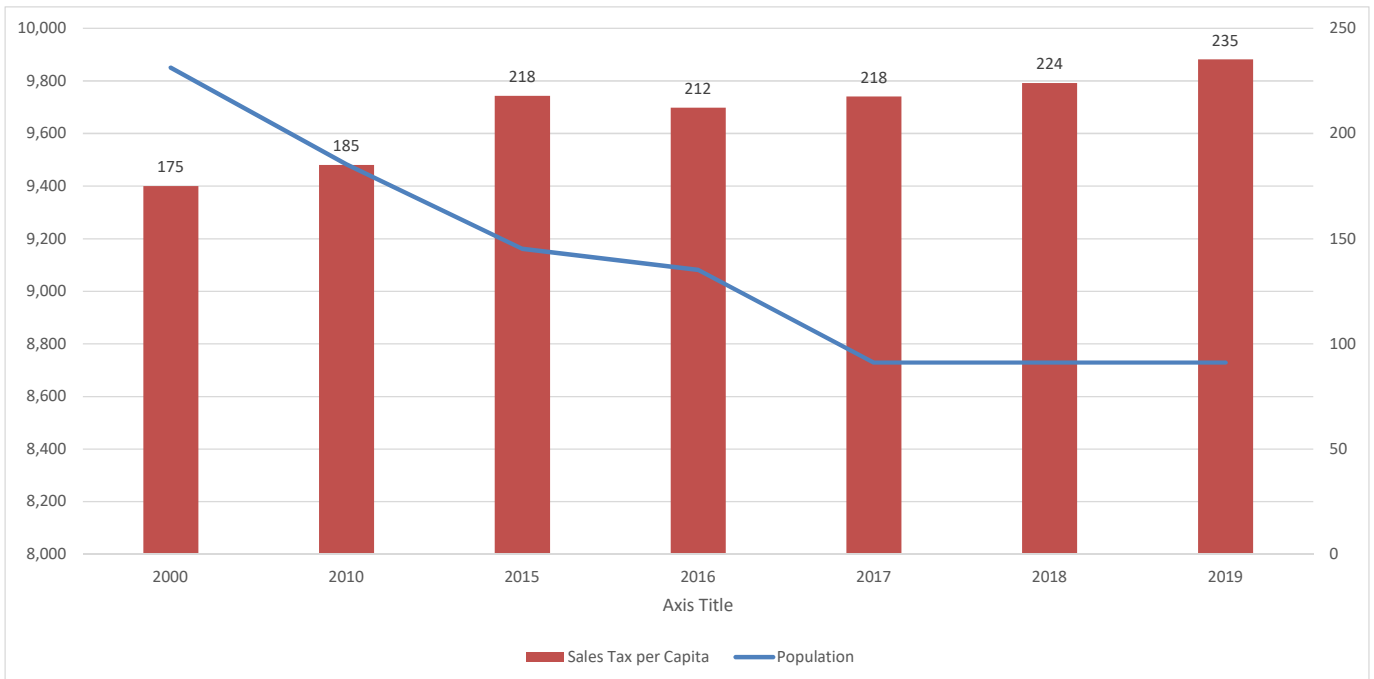
